

Food Scraps Recycling Equipment Guidelines

Tompkins County residents may sign out a Food Scraps Tool Kit (kitchen caddy, transportation container and disposable liners) free of charge.

Please be aware of the following guidelines:

- ❖ Equipment is provided on a **first come, first serve** basis.
- ❖ Only **ONE** tool kit can be distributed **per household**.
 - Businesses and property managers should contact recyclefood@tomkins-co.org to set-up a food scraps recycling program through our ReBusiness Partners Program.
 - Equipment must be signed out by a household member.
Neighbors/friends/interested persons need to **sign out their own equipment**.
- ❖ Equipment **cannot** be exchanged, replaced, repaired or returned to the Solid Waste Division.

If you need additional equipment:

- ❖ Any bin or container can be creatively reused as a kitchen caddy or transport container, at the convenience of the user.
- ❖ Additional kitchen caddies (\$5) and transport containers (\$12) may be purchased from the Tompkins County Solid Waste Division Office on Commercial Avenue.
- ❖ Alternative containers may also be purchased from local home improvement/hardware stores (Agway, Home Depot, Lowe's, etc.)
